Building permit applicants may use this form to request a reassessment of the cost of the building work if, in the applicant's view, the building permit levy should be decreased because the building work was varied after the cost of the building work was calculated (section 205L(1)(ba) of the *Building Act 1993*).

- Building permit application form previously submitted to your relevant building surveyor when you applied for the building permit
- Building permit issued by your relevant building surveyor
- Amended building permit (if issued)
- Evidence supporting the change in the cost of the building work

- (c) research, planning, to meet the BPC's operational requirements, assessing the merit and impact of proposed regulatory reforms and to assist in the development and delivery of services by the BPC;
- (d) such other purposes as required by law or authorised under the privacy legislation.

The BPC may also share your personal information with third parties including, but not limited to, different business units within the BPC, the Building Appeals Board, Consumer Affairs Victoria, your insurer, other regulators (both in Victoria and interstate), and the BPC's staff and/or service providers who need to know such information to perform services for the BPC.

The BPC will only disclose your personal information to a third party claiming to act on your behalf (for example, your solicitor or interpreter) with your prior written consent.
